Red Wine

- No. 1 **Rioja, San Millan, Crianza**
Spain
Aromas of red ripe fruits with a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and clove. A pleasant entry on the palate with a good finish.
- No. 2 **Garnacha, Bodegas Principe**
Spain
Firm ripe blackberry, cherry and mocha in a long robust finish.
- No. 3 **Shiraz, Wirra Wirra, Good Catch**
McLaren Vale, Australia
A full bodied red made up from Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and a small portion of Petit Verdot.
- No. 4 **Malbec, Beauté de Sud**
France
This modern Malbec, echoes both the old world rusticity of southern France and the inky fruitiness found in the malbecs of Argentina & the rest of the world.
- No. 5 **Cabernet Merlot, Casa Silva**
Chile, Colchagua Valley
Handcrafted from the country's finest strip of vineyard, the renowned Colchagua Valley. This wine which is complex has great depth & character.

Blush

- No. 12 **White Zinfandel Rosé, Fetzer**
California
With a delicious hint of sweetness offset by a tangy Acidity. Intense berry & raspberry fruit burst enthusiastically onto the palate.
Superb summertime drinking!
- No. 13 **Pinot Grigio Rosé, Fabiano**
Italy
This immensely popular rosé is dry but fruity and well balanced. Can be served with food or as an aperitif.

White Wine

- No. 6 **Sauvignon Blanc, Saint Desir**
France
With astonishing aromas of tropical fruits and peach on the nose. The smoothness and intense flavours are held by a refreshing and zesty acidity in the mouth.
- No. 7 **Sauvignon Blanc, Falconhead**
Marlborough, New Zealand
A classic Sauvignon. Made using the best wine making techniques from the old & new worlds.
- No. 8 **Chardonnay, Medalla Real, Santa Rita**
Leyda Valley, Chile
Barrel fermented and undergoes lees stirring. Weighty and creamy on the palate.
- No. 9 **Riesling, Spinyback**
Nelson, New Zealand
Sweet floral aromas of jasmine and honeysuckle combine with grapefruit and lemon characters underpinned by a mineral thread. Refreshing and very moreish indeed!
- No. 10 **Vinho Verde, Casal de Ventozela**
Portugal
Crisp and dry, with delicate flavours of soft citrus fruit, melon and green apple, and aromatic hints of blossom and white pepper. The palate offers refreshing sherbet suggestions.
- No. 11 **Pinot Grigio, San Giorgio**
Italy
A vibrant Pinot Grigio that offers much more character and class than some. Showing citrus fruit flavours and subtle floral aromas. Good acidity helps create a clean, refreshing wine.

- Extra de Codorniu, Cava**
Spain
This is a very lively wine with strong stone fruit flavours but also has a touch of class about it with some subtle toast & biscuity flavours associated with champagne.
- Prosecco, Lucas Botter**
Italy
An attractive biscuity nose, leading onto a bright fruity palate with hints of pears and melon.
An excellent aperitif.
- Mumm, Cordon Rouge NV (Red Ribbon)**
Champagne
Ever popular Champagne that delivers top quality drinking. A fresh easy style bursting with fresh fruits.
- Bollinger Special Cuvée, Brut**
Champagne
Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent. A stylish Champagne, Elegant & refined.
